NDPE-IRF - Overview



- The NDPE Implementation Reporting Framework, or NDPE IRF, is a reporting tool that
 provides a shared and consistent view of progress towards NDPE commitments across
 a full supply base of companies in a supply chain. Please see the NDPE IRF website for
 more information.
- Working with our suppliers, we were able to create a baseline of current performance in our supply chain using the <u>NDP IRF</u>.
- For 2023, 8/9 of our Tier 1 suppliers were able to provide us with full profiles for performance on no deforestation and peatland development for the volumes supplied to General Mills.

NDP-IRF: 5 Categories of Volumes



The NDP-IRF profile is separated into the following 5 categories:

KNOWN ORIGIN

Self-assessment completed.
Traceable volumes, but no known action.

AWARENESS

Part of a group that has a commitment and action plan.
Awareness driven by workshop, site visit or self-assessment.
Grievances present or insufficient action taken.

COMMITMENT & STARTING ACTION

Developed and implementing own action plan.
Grievances are logged and action has begun.
Volumes certified by MSPO, ISPO or ISCC.

PROGRESSING



No Deforestation progress at production level


No Deforestation progress at production level based on estimate of proportion of FFB from directly managed production (%)






Self-Reported

No Peat progress at production level


No Peat progress at production level based on estimate of proportion of FFB from directly managed production (%)

Progress from 2022-2023


